

OKTOBERFEST / TOWN CENTER PARKING LOT RESTRICTIONS

The ENTIRE TOWN CENTER PARKING LOT (formerly known as the “Innercore Parking Lot”) in downtown Boyertown WILL BE CLOSED TO PARKING from 7:00 a.m. Friday September 17th, until midnight Saturday the 18th for the Building a Better Boyertown’s annual OKTOBERFEST event. In case of a weather-related postponement of part of the event, the lot closure will be extended through midnight on Sunday, September 19th.

ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE LOT BY 7:00 a.m. FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 17th, 2021, and may not be returned to parking in the lot until the lot re-opens at midnight either Saturday or Sunday.

Vehicles remaining on the lot or returning to the lot in violation of the temporary restrictions WILL BE TOWED AT THE DIRECTION OF THE POLICE. We do not want to tow anyone’s car. But the lot closure and the event have been approved by Borough Council, and 100% compliance with removal of vehicles is essential for the success of the event. Having vehicles moved in a timely manner according to these restrictions will help to facilitate efficient set-up, and a safe, successful event that will be enjoyed by many, and will highlight much of what our community and our downtown has to offer. If you normally park in the Towne Center Lot, please help to make this event successful, and minimize inconvenience to yourself and others by planning ahead according to the event schedule and the accompanying parking restrictions.
