# BOYERTOWN COMMUNITY POOL

417 S. Madison Street, Boyertown

The Borough of Boyertown owns the community swimming pool located on South Madison Street in the Boyertown Community Park, and has entered into a lease agreement with the Philadelphia Freedom Valley Boyertown Area YMCA for operation of the pool.

The pool will be open the following days (weather permitting):  
Saturday, May 26, through Monday, September 3, 2018.

Special fee for Borough of Boyertown residents.  
Proof of residency is required.

**Family** (includes everyone living in the household) – \$240; **Individual** (ages 2 through adult) – \$120
